# **Curriculum Connections**



## Literacy

Week of: Tanuary

In reading we are beginning our unit on Readers are Brave and Resourceful. Students will learn to be brave word solvers as they attempt multiple strategies to decode unfamiliar words while making meaning from the text. Students will practice using strategies to read the tricky parts of books. We will also continue to review informational texts.

In writing we will begin our unit on writing informational texts. Students will begin by writing How-Tos. Students will learn how to write procedural informational writing. Students will need to include materials and detailed steps.



### Science

We begin our unit on organisms for third quarter. We will began by studying seeds. We planted seeds and discussed what our seeds will need to grow.

#### mathematics

In math we will begin our unit on shapes. Students will learn to distinguish between defining attributes (e.g., triangles are closed and three-sided) versus non-defining attributes (e.g., color, orientation, overall size). Students will compare and identify 2D shapes.

We will start our unit on goods and services and wants and needs third quarter. Students will learn to the various ways in which people carn and use money for goods and services. Students will identify examples of goods and services in the home, school and community.
