

## SCIENCE

We will continue our unit on Balance and Motion. We will begin the section on movement. Students have a project for homework that is due May $30^{\text {th }}$.

## Mathematics

In math we have finished our unit on non standard measurement and are beginning our unit on partitioning shapes. Students will learn to partition circles and rectangles into halves, fourths, and quarters, and use the phrases half of, fourth of, and quarter of. Students will describe the whole as two of, or four of the shares. Understand for these examples that decomposing into more equal shares creates smaller shares.


## Social Studies

We will be using geographic skills to identify areas in our world focusing on ways people change the environment, use natural resources in their Community, and explaining how the environment impacts where people live.
