First Grade News

Curriculum Connections



Literacy

In reading we are focusing on characters within a text. We are looking at ways characters change throughout a story. We will continue to explore characters with readers theatres and other fiction texts.

In writing we have finished our All About books are will share them with our peers. The students worked very hard on these and will bring them home soon but not before we share them! We will begin our last unit on poetry this week. Students will write their own poems. We will also be reviewing all the different types of writing we have learned this year including small moments and opinion letters.



Mathematics

In math we have finished our unit on non standard measurement and are beginning our unit on partitioning shapes. Students will learn to partition circles and rectangles into *halves*, *fourths*, and *quarters*, and use the phrases *half of*, *fourth of*, and *quarter of*. Students will describe the whole as two of, or four of the shares. Understand for these examples that decomposing into more equal shares creates smaller shares.



SCIENCE

We will continue our unit on Balance and Motion. We will begin the section on movement. Students have a project for homework that is due May $30^{\rm th}$.



Social Studies

We will be using geographic skills to identify areas in our world focusing on ways people change the environment, use natural resources in their Community, and explaining how the environment impacts where people live.
