

Curriculum Connections



Literacy

In reading we will be reading informational texts. We will explore the differences between informational texts and fiction texts. Students will continue to work on asking and answering questions in their Read, Write, and Respond Notebooks. We will work with students in small group guided reading, one on one conferences, and whole class lessons.

In writing we have started our new unit on writing opinion pieces. Students will brainstorm things that they have opinions about in the school, home, and community settings. Students will learn how to express their opinions and provide reasons for their opinion. Students will learn how to write in a letter format.



mathematics

In math we will work on subtraction with separate result unknown CGI problems (ex: Ben has 9 pigs. He gave 4 to John. How many pigs does Ben have now?) Students will investigate the differences between addition and subtraction through games and activities. We will also work on other types of problem solving such as Join change unknown (ex: Sally has 6 pens, Jo gave her some more. Now Sally has 10 pens. How many did Jo give Sally?)



SCIENCE

We will begin our unit on Earth Materials. Students will investigate several types of rocks.



Social Studies

We will explore ways that communities celebrate holidays around the world.
