## **Literacy**

In reading we will be working on "Tackling the Tricky Parts". Students are learning strategies to help with accuracy and comprehension when reading. We will learn strategies such as: do the pictures match the words, use the beginning and ending sounds when decoding words, and ask questions throughout the reading process. We will continue with Unit 2 and 3 in Letterland. Students are using strategies such as the rollercoaster and finger tapping to segment and blend words.

In writing we will continue to write about small moments. We will continue work on using words such as next, second, third, finally to tell event order. We will learn strategies to spell unknown words when writing.

We will begin literacy WISE time on Wednesday and Thursday this week.
